Paper format	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Font should be Arial type and 10-point font sizePaper size should be A4 (210x297mm)Number of words: 20,000 (maximum)Authors and their affiliations must be includedMust be submitted in a single A4 Microsoft Word documentAll images and graphs must be included in the Word documentWord document should not exceed 10 MB
Text layout	The following format is recommended: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Introduction/BackgroundAims/ObjectivesDevelopment/Methods (if applicable)Results (if applicable)Summary/conclusions



Other	Subheadings must be 10-point font size and bold. Please use simple paragraphs with a line spacing between each.
Abbreviations / Acronyms:	Should be spelt out in full when first mentioned, followed by the abbreviation or acronym in brackets. E.g. International Gas Union (IGU)
Restrictions	Please keep mentions of brand names to a reasonable minimum. Avoid company logos or branding where possible.
